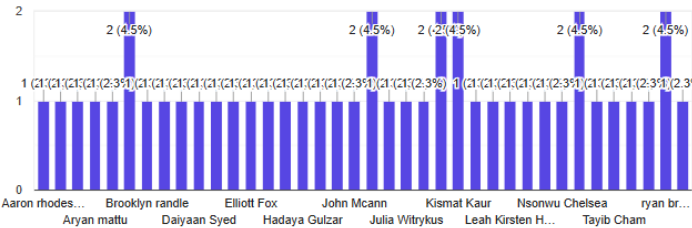

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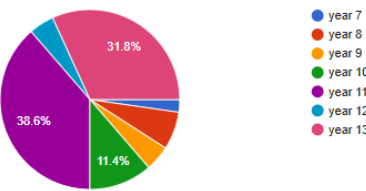

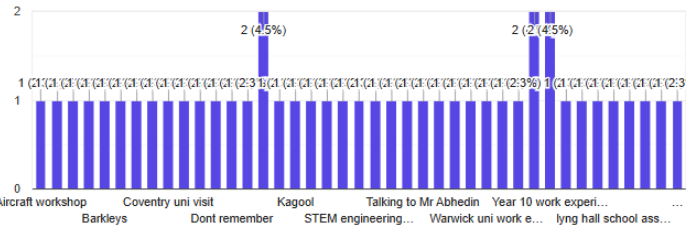

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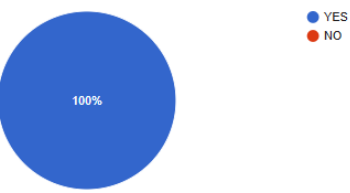

2. After doing the activity, do you have a better knowledge about what it's like to work or be part of a team, or go further in education?

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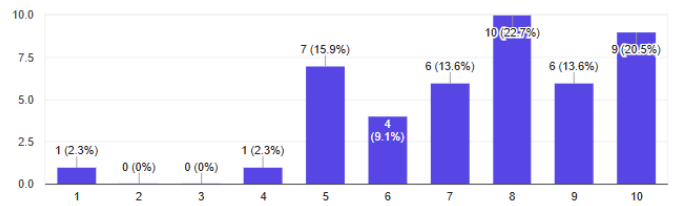

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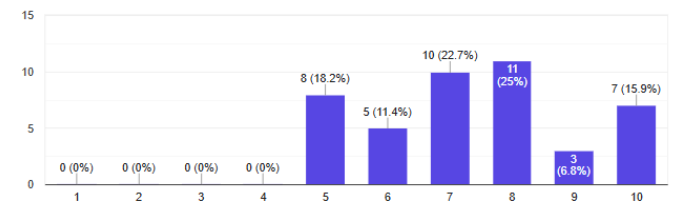

4. After the activity, on a scale of 1-10, how much do you know about the qualifications needed to have a career (related to the activity)

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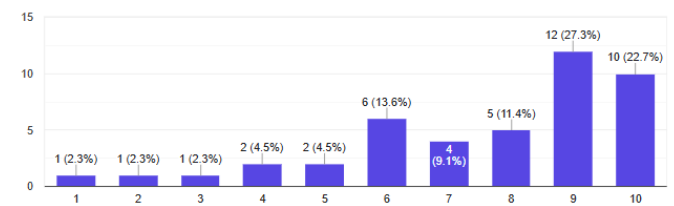

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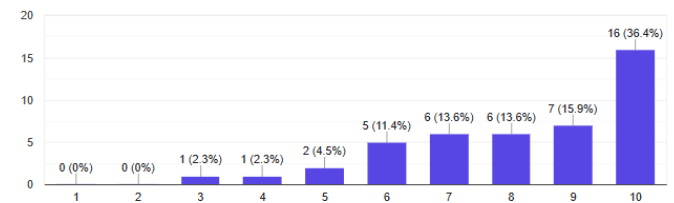

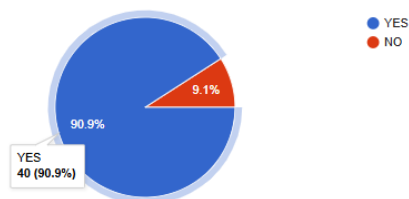
