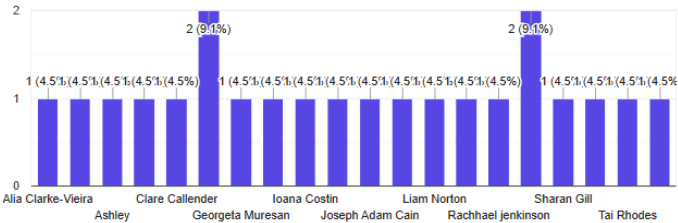

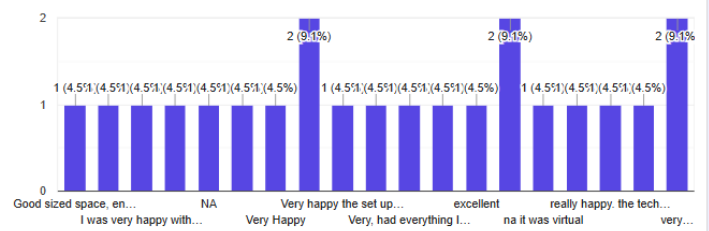

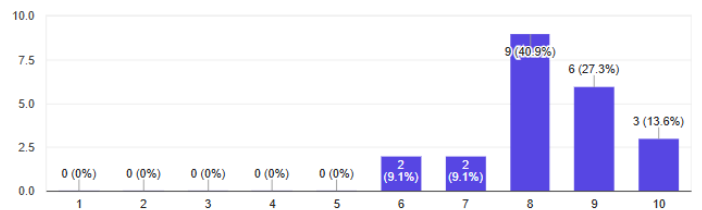

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5. On a scale of 1-10, how much do you think the activity made the pupils you consider a future career?

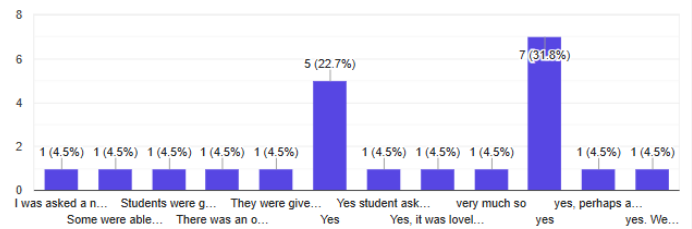

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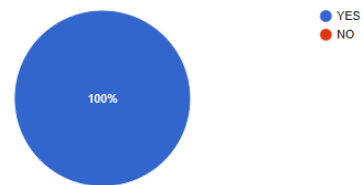

The presentations are repeatable and so can be delivered multiple times across different sessions if needed. I think the fortnightly presentation works better than the weekly as it spaces them out a little more so not to overload students with too much information

the pupils were engaged. they asked relevant questions. I even had a few pupils send their CVS to me, which demonstrates their keenness to learn

Students were attentive and their questions allowed me to build on my previous points and reiterate information. They seemed genuinely interested which is always good to see. The organisation and support from Lyng Hall made the experience much smoother and allowed me to focus on the information I was giving rather than logistics or technological problems.

sessions were short and to the point, not too long that the students lose interest

The pupils were lovely to work with. I thought the staff contributed really well to the session. It was great to see how we were able to merge the sciences curriculum and careers within Severn Trent. the students got to see science in action! We were able to cover many different career paths that can come out of working for severn Trent and it was nice to be able to share personal journeys!

the pupils were receptive and asked challenging questions about careers in STEM. we had pupils interested in aerospace, engineering, computer science and healthcare careers and thankfully, we were able to give them a taste of all or similar.

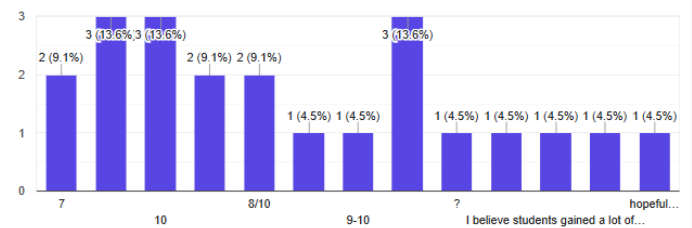

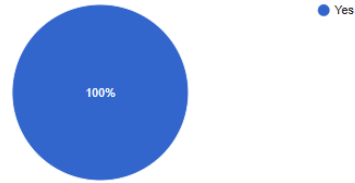
