As part of the Finham Park Multi Academy Trust, we can offer students the opportunity to study at Finham Park School or Finham Park 2, if they offer a subject your child is interested in.

It is compulsory to study three subjects. We offer a mix of A-Level and alternative academic qualifications such as BTEC qualifications.

In order to study the subjects below, we prefer students to have achieved a grade 4 in five GCSE subjects:

- Media
- Sport
- Health and Social Care
- Enterprise
- Music Technology
- Performing Arts
- Law
- Criminology

In order to study the subjects below, students must have achieved a minimum of grade 5 in English and Maths at GCSE, plus a grade 5 in that subject.

- Maths A-Level (level 6 for maths GCSE is required)
- Psychology A-Level
- Sociology A-Level

- Biology A-Level (level 6 for science GCSE is required)
- Physics A-level ((level 6 for science GCSE is required)
- Chemistry A-Level (level 6 for science GCSE is required))
- Art A-Level
- English A-Level

We also offer a level 2 provision for pupils who do not achieve the required grades for studying at level 3, this is a fixed pathway and consists of:

- Functional skills in English
- Functional skills in maths
- Music technology
- Sports science
